“British education in an international context”

How can one impart traditional British educational values to children, and offer an internationally oriented modern education at the same time? How can we prepare young people to become open-minded global citizens who respect diversity and difference, yet who are also taught universal moral and educational principles? What are the distinguishing characteristics of a British education? What are the differences from and similarities with an international educational experience?

These are some of the questions Mr Graham Lacey, Head of Berlin British School since September 2010, will be posing, and attempting to answer, in his lecture "A British education in an International Context" to the Deutsch-Englische Gesellschaft.

Mr Graham Lacey will analyse the liberal tradition in British education: the Socratic Method of pedagogy, the tradition of educating the whole person, and the principles of breadth, variety and balance. He will suggest how the liberal tradition may be placed in a contemporary and international context by focusing on global educational values. In particular, he will refer to the principles of the International Baccalaureate (IB) programme of learning; and last, but not least, how these educational principles are reflected in the identity and values of Berlin British School.

Mr Graham Lacey studied History at the University of St. Andrews University and went on to teach at the renowned Sevenoaks School from 1986, where he started as a history teacher and later became Deputy Head. Mr Lacey obtained the National Professional Qualification for Headship in 2008. At Sevenoaks, he was responsible for managing the school's transition to an all-IB Diploma sixth form curriculum. From 2007, he developed and headed the school's Centre for Innovation and Excellence. He intends to draw on his extensive experience in the British education system to take Berlin British School on to the next stage of its development and success.
